

W3 Outfitters Muzzleloader Hunters Check List

Please Note: Each person is **limited to 70#** of gear/supplies, not including weapon
All belongings should be packed in a container/bag no bigger than a 48qt cooler

REQUIRED GEAR

- Hunter Safety Card—required if born on or after January 1, 1949
- License(s) for game you are hunting
- Sub-zero sleeping bag and a pillow
- 2-way radio
- Canteen
- Day Pack
- Small flashlight with extra batteries
- Watch
- Sharp hunting knife
- Firestarter and matches (waterproof)
- 500 sq. inches of fluorescent orange (hat & vest)
- Rain Gear
- Towel & wash cloth

SUGGESTED GEAR

- Pair of binoculars
- Cow elk call & bugle
- Sunglasses
- Lip salve/Chapstick/Sunscreen
- Camera and film
- We recommend a muzzleloader that is at least 50 caliber
- Muzzleloader sighted in for 50 yards
- Extra ramrod
- Clothing for temperatures ranging from 70 degrees above to 15 degrees below zero. **Layers work best.**
 - Insulated waterproof leather boots
 - Rubber boots
 - Wool and light weight socks
 - Heavy underwear
 - Heavy & lightweight shirts
 - Gloves (waterproof)
 - Pants (regular & wool)
 - Coats
 - Coveralls
 - Bandana or scarf
 - Moist wipes (for hygiene purposes)

Note: If hunting in a drop camp you will need the following items also:

- First Aid Kit
- Food & drinks
- Paper Plates/foam cups/plastic ware/trash bags/ any other paper products
- Game bags
- 50 ft of rope and duct tape
