

## W3 Outfitters Archery Hunters Check List

Please Note: Each person is limited to 70# of gear

### Required Gear

- \_\_\_ Hunter Safety Card – required if born after January 1, 1949
- \_\_\_ Sleeping bag and pillow
- \_\_\_ Day pack
- \_\_\_ Canteen
- \_\_\_ Small flashlight, batteries
- \_\_\_ Watch
- \_\_\_ Sharp hunting knife
- \_\_\_ Firestarter and matches (waterproof)
- \_\_\_ License for game you are going to be hunting
- \_\_\_ Safety belt
- \_\_\_ Bow Sling

### Suggested Gear

- \_\_\_ Pair of binoculars
- \_\_\_ Cow elk call
- \_\_\_ Sunglasses
- \_\_\_ Lip salve/Chapstick/Sunscreen
- \_\_\_ Camera and film
- \_\_\_ We recommend a bow with at least 60 lbs of pull (broadhead must be 7/8 “ wide w/2 blades)
- \_\_\_ A Dozen arrows
- \_\_\_ Bow sighted in for 10-40 yds
- \_\_\_ Clothing for temperatures ranging from 70 degrees above to 15 below zero (layers work best)
  - \_\_\_ Insulated leather boots (waterproof)
  - \_\_\_ Rubber boots
  - \_\_\_ Wool and light weight socks
  - \_\_\_ Heavy underwear
  - \_\_\_ Camouflage shirts (heavy and lightweight)
  - \_\_\_ Gloves
  - \_\_\_ Rain Gear
  - \_\_\_ Pants (regular and wool)
  - \_\_\_ Coats
  - \_\_\_ Bandana or scarf
  - \_\_\_ Extra release or finger tab
  - \_\_\_ Extra bow string
  - \_\_\_ Couple boxes of baking soda or scent shield
  - \_\_\_ Any personal items you might need
  - \_\_\_ Towel and washcloth
  - \_\_\_ Moist baby wipes

NOTE: If hunting in drop camp you will need the following items also:

- \_\_\_ First aid kit
- \_\_\_ Food and drinks
- \_\_\_ Paper plates/foam cups, plastic spoons/forks
- \_\_\_ Toilet paper and paper towels
- \_\_\_ Trash bags
- \_\_\_ Game bags
- \_\_\_ 50 foot of rope and duct tape
