

W3 Outfitters Muzzleloader Hunters Check List

Please Note: Each person is limited to 70# of gear

Required Gear

- ___ Hunter Safety Card – required if born after January 1, 1949
- ___ Sleeping bag and pillow (sub-zero sleeping bag)
- ___ Day pack
- ___ Canteen
- ___ Small flashlight, batteries
- ___ Watch
- ___ Sharp hunting knife
- ___ 500 sq. inches of fluorescent orange (vest & hat)
- ___ Firestarter and matches (waterproof)
- ___ License for game you are going to be hunting

Suggested Gear

- ___ Pair of binoculars
- ___ Cow elk call and bugle
- ___ Sunglasses
- ___ Lip salve/Chapstick/Sunscreen
- ___ Camera and film
- ___ We recommend a muzzleloader that is at least 50 caliber
- ___ Muzzleloader sighted in for 50 yds
- ___ Extra ramrod
- ___ Clothing for temperatures ranging from 70 degrees above to 15 below zero (layers work best)
 - ___ Insulated rubber boots (waterproof)
 - ___ Rubber boots
 - ___ Wool and light weight socks
 - ___ Heavy underwear
 - ___ Heavy and lightweight shirts
 - ___ Gloves (waterproof)
 - ___ Rain Gear
 - ___ Pants (regular and wool)
 - ___ Coats
 - ___ Coveralls
 - ___ Bandana or scarf
 - ___ Any personal items you might need
 - ___ Towel and washcloth
 - ___ Moist baby wipes

NOTE: If hunting in drop camp you will need the following items also:

- ___ First aid kit
- ___ Food and drinks
- ___ Paper plates/foam cups, plastic spoons/forks
- ___ Toilet paper and paper towels
- ___ Trash bags
- ___ Game bags
- ___ 50 foot of rope and duct tape
